STEAMitUp Workshops in Cyprus June & September 2021

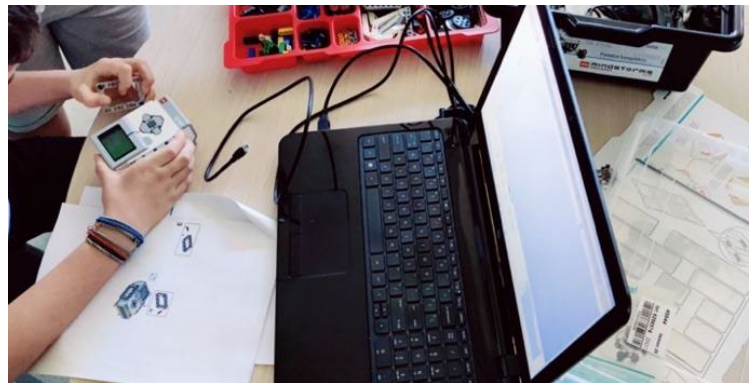
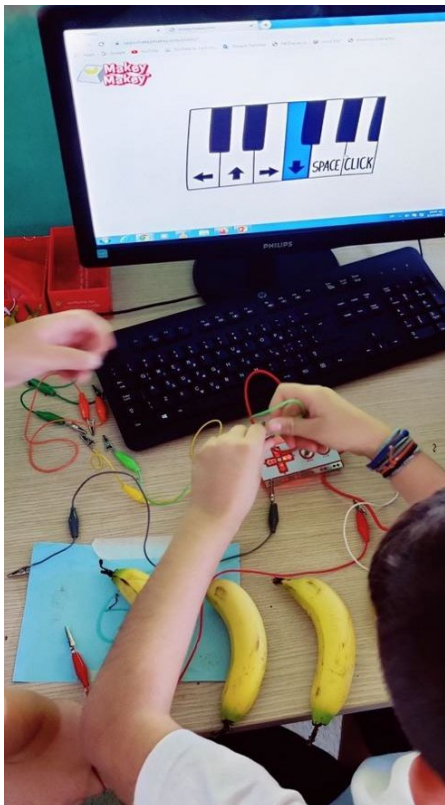
Primary school teacher workshops were held to introduce and evaluate the material and resources of the STEAMitUp project (Toolkit & e-learning platform) on STEM education. CARDET delivered three local workshops for the requirements of the third output namely, IO3 “STEAMitUP Impact assessment study and practice recommendations”. A total of 18 primary school teachers attended physically a series of workshops on Thursday June 17th, 2021, in the form of an all-day seminar at Potamos Germasogeias Primary school in Limassol.



During the delivery of the first workshop, teachers were introduced to the rationale of the STEAMitUP project focusing on its main purpose and key objectives.



Following the training, two of the teachers who participated in the workshops, designed, and delivered a series of STEAM lessons using a variety of technological equipment. Around 40 students participated in the implementation phase of the project.



Overall, both workshops and implementations worked well. Despite the uncertain times with the pandemic, IO3 has been successfully completed. Teachers during training as well as students in the implementation phase were actively engaged in the process and we received positive feedback.
